

Greetings!

We have some good news to kick off February!

Starting today, elders, unaccompanied youth, people with disabilities, and other households without minor children can begin applying for fiscal year 2018 homelessness prevention funds through the Residential Assistance for Families in Transition program (RAFT, line item 7004-9316). Building upon last year's \$500,000 pilot, up to \$2 million will be made available between now and June 30th by the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) to help households without children avoid or exit homelessness.

As you may recall, the Legislature included the \$2 million in the overall \$15 million FY'18 RAFT line item, but Governor Baker vetoed the funds and language that expanded the definition of family beyond households with children under the age of 21. The Legislature overrode the veto in the fall, and we have been working since then to make sure the funds would be released to serve hundreds of households experiencing housing instability. Households approved for RAFT can receive up to \$4,000 to help with expenses such as back rent, back utility bills, first month's rent, last month's rent, and security deposits.
