Greetings!

While we <u>await the finalization of the FY'20 state budget</u>, we also are looking ahead to an important bill hearing at the State House.

On Tuesday, July 16th, the Joint Committee on Children, Families, and Persons with Disabilities will hold a hearing at the State House on a number of key bills, including three bills from our priority list:

- . An Act relative to the safety, dignity, and civil rights of persons experiencing homelessness (House Bill 150/Senate Bill 76; also known as the "Act of Living" bill, a companion to the bill of rights for people experiencing homelessness); fact sheet
- An Act to reduce deep poverty among kids (House Bill 102)/An Act to lift children out of deep poverty (Senate Bill 36); fact sheet
- An Act to end child homelessness (<u>House Bill 160</u>); <u>bill details</u>

The hearing is scheduled for July 16th, 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. in Hearing Room B-1 in the basement of the State House, near the Ashburton Entrance. Here are the hearing details, including a full list of bills to be heard at the hearing, and a <u>list of committee members</u>, including the House Chair, Representative Kay Khan, and the Senate Chair, Senator Sonia Chang-Diaz.

- Provide brief oral testimony to the committee in support of one or more of the key bills (usually no more than 2-3 minutes in length)
- Provide written testimony to the committee in support of one or more of the key bills
